

A BRIEF STATEMENT FOR THE INFORMATION OF PARENTS OF NON-PREFERENCE STUDENTS

This statement is to be read (*and signed*) by parent/s / caregiver/s prior to their application for the enrolment of their child/ren as a non-preference student/s in a State-integrated Catholic Primary School.

1. The Special Character of a State-Integrated Catholic School is defined in the school's Integration Agreement as follows:

"The school is a Roman Catholic school in which the whole school community, through the general school programme and in its religious instructions and observances, exercises the right to live and teach the values of Jesus Christ. These values are as expressed in the Scriptures and in the practices, worship and doctrine of the Roman Catholic Church, as determined from time to time by the Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese."

2. As a State-Integrated Catholic school it focuses on Christ, and has the following goals for your child:

- To develop a knowledge and understanding of the holy scriptures and a sensitivity to them as the Word of God speaking in our lives.
- To develop a knowledge of Catholic doctrine understood in the light of its development and tradition under the teaching authority of the Catholic Church.
- To develop an ability to pray which can grow and deepen.
- To develop an ability to understand and to share actively and personally in the liturgy.
- To promote a sense of belonging to the Church which will lead to an active participation in its life.
- To promote a faith which gives unity and meaning to personal life, to responsibilities and events which occur.
- To promote the ability to relate to others in a way that reflects the evangelical commandment of love.
- To develop the ability to make moral judgements and decisions and to see them as a way of realising a relationship with Christ.
- To promote the ability to discern Christian values in life in this world and to act in accordance with them.

3. Educational Philosophy:

Striving for excellence in all its dimensions is at the heart of the Christian message and is the framework within which Catholic schools operate. Our philosophy of education focuses on establishing high standards and expectations of achievement for students and staff as this is the hallmark of authentic Catholic education. Providing opportunities for young people to genuinely work towards achieving their potential, whatever their talents happen to be, is fundamental to quality Catholic education.

4. The Uniqueness and Value of the Individual:


