

Diocesan Catholic Integrated Schools' Update

Following the February 2011 earthquake, St Paul's School (Dallington) was deemed to be in the red zone. Thus St Paul's School cannot return to its Gayhurst Road site.

Currently St Paul's School is housed on the Ministry of Education's Champion Street site until the end of 2013; with a right to extend this until the end of the 2014 school year.

The Minister of Education has agreed in principle to support the Bishop of Christchurch's request for a consultation process on the following proposal:

Proposal

St Paul's School and Our Lady of Fatima School combine to form a new school on the existing Our Lady of Fatima School site (Mairehau), for the 2015 school year.

The Ministry will commence a formal community consultation on this proposal during Term 4, 2012. The exact timing of this community consultation will be confirmed by the Minister of Education in the coming weeks. This community consultation will be undertaken by an external facilitator.
